II. Application

1. Requirements

Length of Study	■ One Semester ■ One Year
Language Requirements	Ewha does not request an official language proficiency score, but students should be able to take courses in either English or Korean.
GPA	Minimum GPA of over 2.5/4.0 (75/100 or higher academic grade)

2. Eligibility

1. Full-time student in any 4-year accredited institution of higher education
2. Enrolled as a full-time student (completed at least ONE semester)
3. GPA equivalent or over 2.5/4.0(75/100)
4. Ability to take courses in either English or Korean (NO language test score required)

3. Application Period (1 semester before)

Semester Period	Spring (March. 2 ~ June. 16)	Fall (Sept. 1 ~ Dec. 16)
Nomination Period	Sept. 15 ~ Oct. 31 (At previous year)	March 15 ~ April 30
Application Period	Oct. 15 ~ Nov. 15 (At previous year)	April 15 - May 15

If not nominated, students will not be able to finalize their online registration for exchange program.

4. Application Procedure

- Step 1. Create an account at the online application site for exchange or study abroad student at:

- Step 2. Submit application and upload all documents and materials needed for the application.
- Step 3. Receive email notification of approval.
- Step 4. Receive the admission packet sent out via express mail
(Exchange Student: University, Study Abroad (Visiting): Home Address)
- Step 5. Submit Flight information and Insurance Information at Application "Checklist"
(Students may chose Ewha's collective insurance plan)
- Step 6. Come to Ewha!





5. Application Materials

Applicants are asked to submit all of the following materials during online application process.

Ewha requires only the digital documents for student's application. All documents must be prepared in English or Korean, and in JPG or PDF format.

- **Standard ID photo**

Photographs should be in 3 cm x 4 cm size, scanned and saved in a JPG format.

- **Official Academic Transcript**

A transcript which states the cumulative GPA is required to be submitted. If the home institution does not have a GPA system, a signed official letter from the international office guaranteeing that the applicant's academic achievement is over 75% needs to be submitted with the official academic transcript.

- **Health & Medical Clearance Form**

- **Passport copy**

Please copy the first page which has your name and passport number.

- **Statement of Purpose**

Stating student's purpose and plans of international exchange program study at Ewha, write in English/Korean. 1500 ~ 4000 English letters (1500 ~ 2000 Korean characters)

- **Statement Agreement**

- **Overseas Health Insurance Certificate (This will be additionally requested to students admitted)**

1. Tuition & Fees

Students are expected to pay for the tuition and other fees after arrival at Ewha.

Students are given an invoice at the New Student Orientation held before the start of the semester. All fees should be paid in cash at the on-campus bank (Shinhan Bank) or through bank transfer. No personal checks or credit cards will be accepted. Students will also be informed on using on-campus bank at the orientation.
