Bachelor and Master of Science programs entirely offered in English are:

Bachelor of Science (Laurea, 3 years)

- Automotive Engineering
- Computer Engineering
- Electronic Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering
- Telecommunication Engineering

Moreover, the first year of Architecture and of all the other engineering programs is also offered in English. Students wishing to enrol in an Engineering Bachelor Degree program must pass an admission test whose contents are explained on the following webpage: http://orienta.polito.it/Prova_ammissione.html. After filling in the online application Apply@polito (see next paragraph), the applicant will be able to visualize useful materials to train for the test (training samples, tutorials and so on).

Please note that degree programs in Architecture have a selective entry access defined by national standards.

The selective admission test will focus on general knowledge, with particular relevance to the historical, social and institutional fields and capacity to work on written texts of various kinds (artistic, literary, historical, sociological, philosophical, etc.) and attitude to abstract-logical reasoning both in mathematics and language fields.

Information on admission test dates will be available approximately in June.

In order to enrol in Architecture programs, students must both be included in the number of available places set every year by Politecnico for non-European students residing outside of Italy, and achieve the minimum score of 20 points to 80 during the admission test.

HOW TO APPLY

APPLY@POLITO is the online application service of Politecnico di Torino available on http://apply.polito.it/info_en.html. Through this service it is possible to apply for different programs (Bachelor, Master of Science, 1st and 2nd level Specializing Masters, PhD).

For 2013/2014 academic year it is necessary to register and submit the online application within **28th February 2013** (deadline for Bachelor and Master of Science programs).

After going through the evaluation of the International Admissions Office, the academic career and the quality of each candidate are assessed by a Committee of Professors which will decide if he meets the entry requirements for a specific program.

The evaluation of an application through the online service does not exclude the pre-enrolment procedure in compliance with the rules decided by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs: the enrolment to Politecnico will be possible only after completing the compulsory pre-enrolment procedure through the Italian Embassy/Consulate. Since many foreign students are interested in studying at Politecnico, also submitting the online application is mandatory: this way Politecnico will be able to evaluate applications in large advance and it will be easier for the offices to support and guide prospective students during the different steps (welcome, enrolment, etc.).

FREE SERVICES

Students at their arrival could benefit from:

- help in finding an accommodation and health insurance
- Fiscal Code application and Residence Permit. There are specific desks inside the Politecnico
- Assistance by international mentor students
- Free intensive Italian language course
- Reduced price for students' canteen
- Sports activities with the collaboration of C.U.S. (Torino Sports Centre)
- Psychological and counselling activities to support students with problems
- Part-time jobs dedicated to students through calls

The Foreign Citizens Service Office is in charge of accommodation, residence permit, intercultural communication, health insurance and practical information (foreign.citizens@polito.it).

The applicants, who will not be eligible for Politecnico scholarships, can apply at their arrival to the call "Edisu Piemonte scholarships" (<http://www.edisu.piemonte.it/>). Edisu scholarship winners have an amount of money (it means tuition fees exemption as well), accommodation and students' canteen.
