1. EUROPEAN INTEGRATION 5 ECTS	> This two-week intensive course will provide students with a detailed understanding of the main European institutions and the EU decision-making process. Students will also develop critical thinking and learn how to negotiate within a European context.
2. INTERCULTURAL MANAGEMENT 5 ECTS	With the globalization of business, understanding culture differences has never been so important. Through this two-week intensive course, students will learn how to manage, interact and do business on the worldwide stage. This course will offer an understanding of other cultures and ethnicities as a way to improve interaction and negotiation skills with international peers.
3. CULTURAL ACTIVITIES 1 ECTS	During the IÉSEG Winter Program, students will also attend online cultural activities. This will be a unique opportunity to know more about Paris and the French culture!



FACULTY

Dr Adam STEINHOUSE is a Faculty MIB Professor at IÉSEG and was formerly Head of the School of European Studies at the UK National School of Government. Previously, he taught European Politics at the universities of Oxford, Cambridge and the London School of Economics, and he was a commentator for the BBC and CNN on European and North American affairs. His book, "Workers' Participation in Post-Liberation France", was published by Lexington Books. Born in Montreal, Adam graduated with a BA from Harvard University and a DPhil from Oxford University.

Benoît CHALIFOUX graduated from Université Paris Dauphine with an Executive Master in Business (EMBA). He also has an MBA and a BAA of ESG UQAM. Benoît Chalifoux is an international speaker specialized in the field of soft skills. He is also a lecturer at the School of Management of the Université du Québec in Montreal (ESG UQAM) and in other European institutions. He also taught across the globe while supporting various start-ups and wrote "Être à son meilleur, l'incroyable pouvoir des habiletés relationnelles", a book on interpersonal skills.
